

## **Resolution U - Response – In-Transit Loss Account**

The Board has been provided direction by their partners in the In-Transit Loss Account (processors and truckers) that they are not interested in resurrecting the program and producers are encouraged to examine their insurance policies to confirm what is covered on farm and to verify the details of your cargo insurance, or that of your trucker.

A preliminary review conducted in July of 2007 to create a new producer-funded program estimated the cost at 12 to 32 cents/hog depending on coverage, losses, price and volumes. The Board is not supportive of any initiative that brings unnecessary added cost to producers at this time. Since the ITLA was ended, there has been little demand or need demonstrated for this type of program, in large part due to the diligence of producers and their industry partners in adjusting loading and transport times to better support the welfare of their animals.
