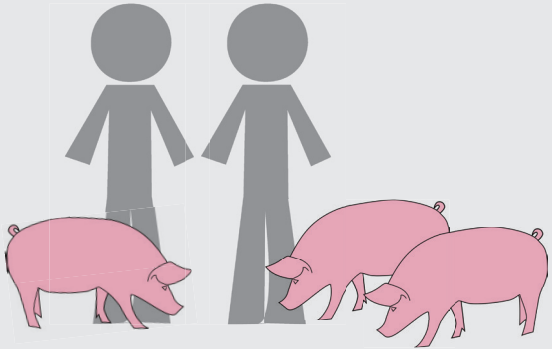

ONTARIO PORK



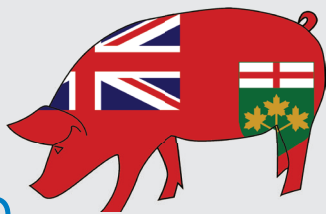
1,284 pork producers in Ontario marketed 5.39 million hogs in 2016, approximately 4.3% more than 2015.

Statistics Canada numbers for the 6-month period ending July 1, 2016:

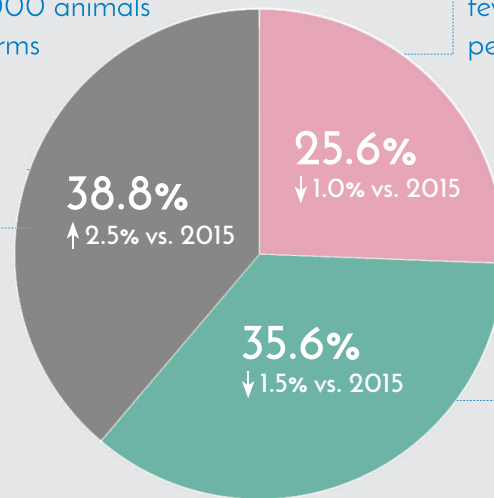

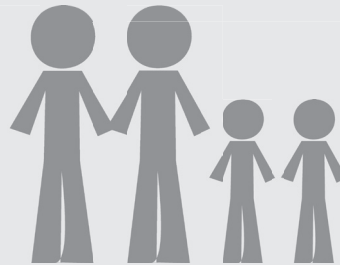


Producers who market more than 3,000 animals per year as farms continue to specialize and grow in size.

Ontario's swine industry remains dominated by the family farm.

More than **98%**

of Canada's farms are still family owned and operated.

The diversity of the 1,284 producers is their strength, but also makes it hard to describe "average" or "typical" farms.

From "farm to fork" in 2015, Ontario's pork industry generated:

- **\$932.8 million** in GDP
- **\$2.7 billion** in economic output
- **17,015** full-time equivalent jobs

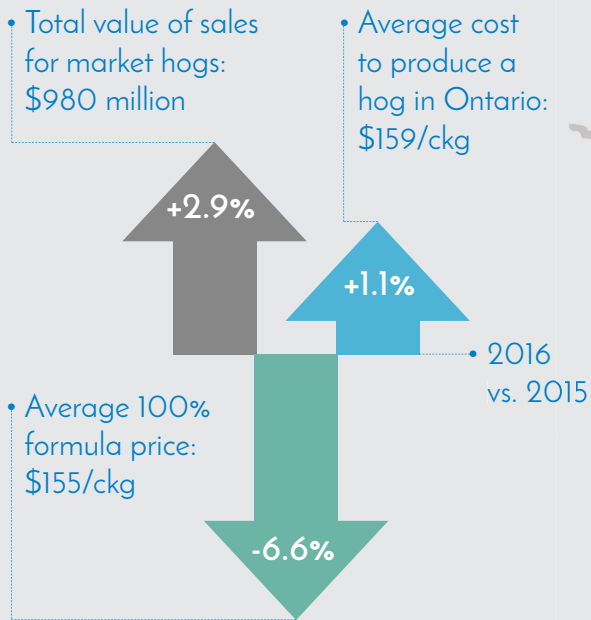

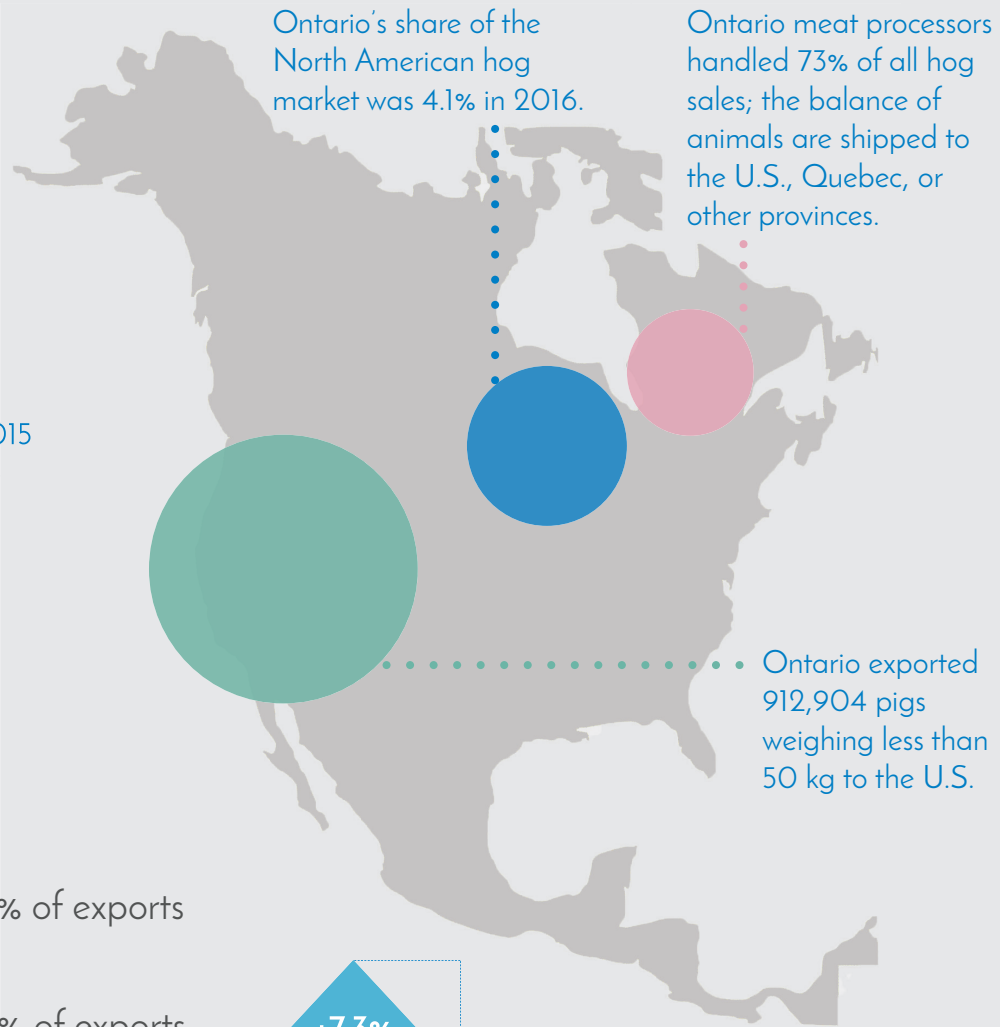
